The world's first self-propelled combine built by George Berry in California has been submitted as a potential ASABE Historic Landmark. Status may be awarded just prior to the upcoming Section Meeting. The nomination was led by Bill Chancellor and Grahame Quick, in conjunction with people at and associated with the Tulare County Museum in Visalia, California. The Section leadership approved the nomination, as is required by the ASABE M-170 Historical Commemoration Committee. We are not certain if the plaque ceremony will occur during the World Ag Expo or in April during the Antique Equipment Show (held on World Ag Expo grounds).
