Congratulations to our newest officer, Joshua Peppers for being elected as our ASABE CA/NV Section Career Development Chair! Take a little bit to get to know him and read his short bio:

I grew up in Iowa and frequently worked on my grandfather's corn and soybean farm. My interest in science and technology combined with agriculture led me to study agricultural engineering at Iowa State University. After graduating in 2006, I volunteered with Engineering Ministries International in Guatemala as a civil engineer with focus on water supply and treatment from commercial and residential buildings. After the four month internship in Guatemala, I joined Archer Daniels Midland company as a production engineer in a corn ethanol facility in Nebraska. With ADM, I supervised a shift of operators for the front-end of the ethanol process- mainly the corn cleaning, grinding, and separation process. I also worked as a process engineer in their corn syrup refinery developing and executing process improvement projects. Working in the ethanol industry peaked my interest in renewable energy. Following ADM, I got a master's degree from UC Davis in biosystems engineering in 2013. I left academia for about three years to work in industry and consulting before returning to UC Davis in 2014 to pursue a PhD in biogas processing. My goals this year are to help others within the ASABE organization realize their career aspirations and to pass the PE exam in mechanical engineering. Outside of work, I balance my responsibilities as a husband and a father of a newborn with my passion for running and other sports.
